- Block Grant Performance Indicators
- National Outcome Measures
- Dashboards for various program areas
- Key Performance Measures
- Reports to the legislature
- System level monitoring
- Performance-based contracting (limited)
- Ad hoc requests
- Planning and pushing policy

How will we use data in the future as part of a flexible/global budget? ...in a more meaningful way.

- Connect outcomes to funds
- Manage to outcomes through contracts
- To drive the system towards certain goals
- As part of a transparent process for improving services
- Create consistent accountability among funding sources
- System evaluation

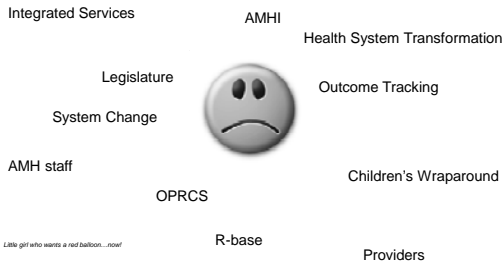

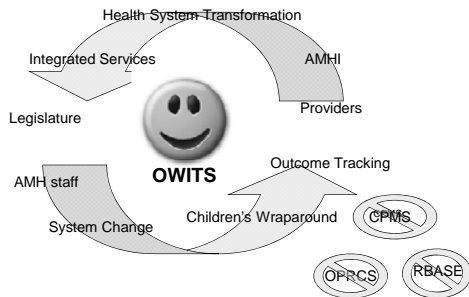
Draft Outcomes and Metrics Currently "on the table"

- Follow up from facility-based care within 7-14 days
- Readmission rates at 30 and 180 days
- % of Tx participants reunited with Child
- Improved Housing
- Improved Employment
- Improved Criminal Justice
- Person receives appropriate level of care
- Rate of outpatient and facility based care treatment reflects community needs
- Initiation with service
- Engagement with service
- Specialized measures of the impact of prevention services including statewide and local performance measures
