- **High end services carved out and the state financially responsible**

- **Up hill challenge to have the community accept more responsibility**

Issues_(Cont.)

- **Currently state supports EBPs through special funding to select counties.**

- **Need to determine how to focus more on outcomes and less on services and advance EBPs**

Various Initiatives

- **Co-management of the civil commitment population at the state hospital**
 - **Financial disincentives for individuals in hospital beyond discharge readiness**

ADDICTIONS & MENTAL HEALTH
SYSTEM CHANGE-



- **Adult Mental Health Initiative (AMHI)**
 - **Contract special flexible funds to MHOs to move individuals to lower levels of care**
 - **Financial incentives**
 - **MHOs have met targets and there is more movement**
- **Overall fewer people in the state hospital for civil commitment**

The Future

- Focus on outcomes
- Move responsibility of the residential/state hospital level of care to the community
- Potential move of the residential level of care to Coordinating Care Organizations

- Increased emphasis on prevention and early intervention
- Eventual move for forensic system of care to local level
