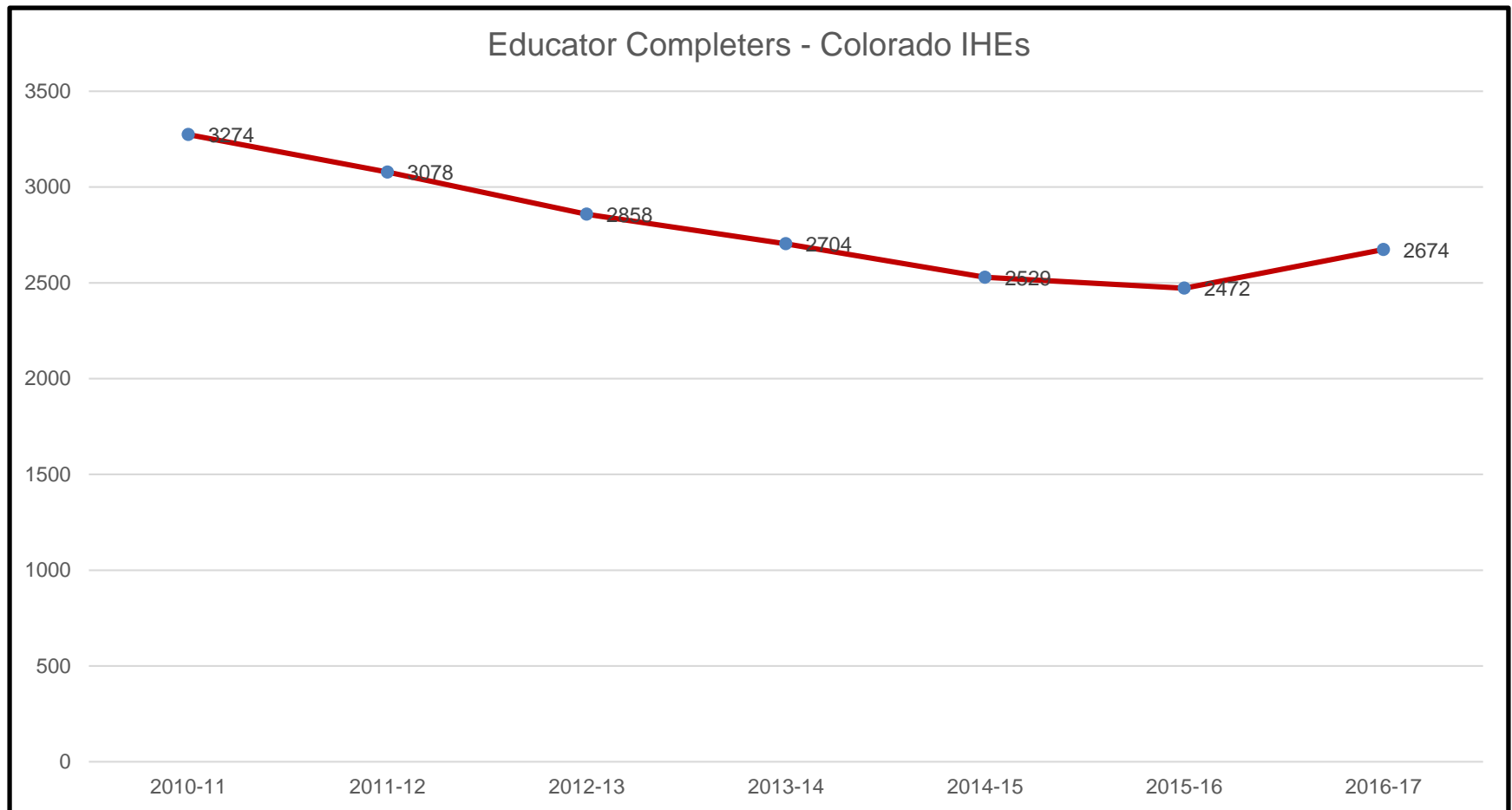

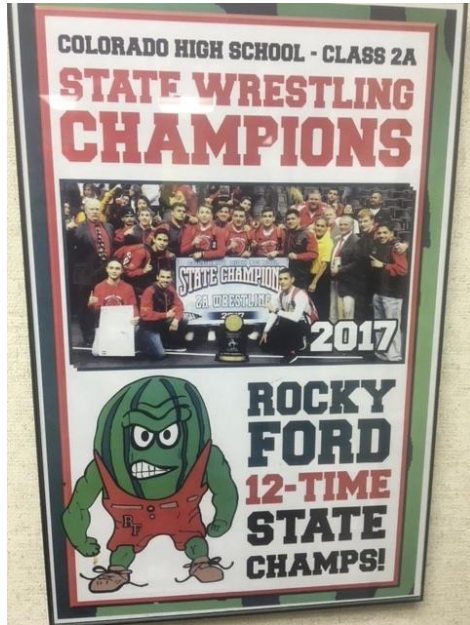
Colorado student numbers continue to rise
