

CHALLENGES TO ADOPTING OER



Knowledge & Motivation

General misunderstanding of what "OER" means.

Content Selection

Identifying good resources/textbooks and the criteria or process of selection.

Technical Issues

Skills to search, download, and author original content in a digital format.

Sustainability

Not enough time to find, download, and edit OER and keep it up to date and current.






OER PROGRAM FOUNDATION

Yavapai College has been working to lower textbook costs for students through our Open Educational Resource (OER) program since Fall 2020.

- College allocated funds to the OER project.
- OER committee was established.
- OER policy developed, adopted, and implemented.
- Course coding structure created (OERZ and Low Cost).
- Faculty training built and offered.
- Faculty stipend scale reviewed and approved.

AREAS OF SUPPORT









OER BUILD TIERS

- Adopt/Adapt
 - An entire course exists that align with YC outcomes, most of the work under an "adopt/adapt" will consist of content review, selection, and adoption.
- Semi-Build
 Some material that align with YC outcomes exist but not an entire course. Faculty will need to author original content or assessments.
- Full Build

 There is not available material that align with YC outcomes, and the faculty member will need to create the entire course.

OER COURSE DEVELOPMENT PATH



To have a course labeled as OER, a faculty member will....

Start Here

Complete OER training course



Submit request to adopt/adapt, semi-build, or full-build an OER course



Wait to receive approval from the VP of Academic Affairs. All OER build requests are reviewed by the Manager of Academic Initiatives and the VP of Academic Affairs.



Once approved, receive support from our OER librarian and an Instructional Designer. Faculty can set up meetings to receive curation support or course design support.

Once course is completed, submit to the Teaching & eLearning (TeLS) team for review.



TeLS uses our OER course review template to review and ensure the course meets all approved criteria of course alignment, licensing, and accessibility. If needed, an instructional designer will meet with faculty if revisions are needed.




Once course is approved, faculty will receive their approved stipend amount and the course will be labeled as an OER Zero Cost Textbook Course. Students can search for those courses when they register.



OER ENROLLMENT

\$802,340

Using an average cost of \$110 per textbook, Yavapai College has saved students approximately \$802,340 Fall 2020 through Spring 2022.



NEXT SEMESTER CREDITS

Based on the data, students enrolled in two or more OER courses carried an average of 2.5 more next semester credits than those students who did not take any OER courses.

First Term	Fall 2020	Spring 2021	Fall 2021	Average
2 or More OER Courses	11.9	9.9	11.1	11.0
2 or More Non-OER Courses	8.0	9.7	7.6	8.4



WHAT STUDENTS ARE SAYING

"Honesty, I really liked the materials provided. I prefer OER materials like this because they are so much less costly and if printed, I can write my notes and highlight things directly on the text without having to worry about damage fees. Plus, there was no extra cost to keep the materials, so I can refer to them if I ever need to in the future..."

"That \$110 as could buy groceries for my family for a week."

"Yes, when registering for classes I now look for courses that do not require me to purchase a textbook."

"It makes a difference as I am able to focus on my course work rather than having to come up with money to pay for my books. Since it takes me a few weeks to collect enough money to purchase books I end up falling behind on class work."



"It makes continuing education less expensive than when you factor in all cost. Saving on books makes going to school more attainable."

STRATEGIES TO REPLICATE



OER Committee

Established YC's initial OER policies and guidelines, continues to review and revise as needed, and supports new OER initiatives.



Coding OER Courses

Allows students to easily search OER courses when registering and administration to college data for future decisions regarding OER.



OER Faculty Training

A six-week self-paced training to teach faculty about OER, Creative Commons license, and how to build their own OER course.



Faculty Facing Website

Developed a website focusing on educating faculty on what is OER, the benefits of using OER in their class, and how to participate in YC's OER program.
